Sandra Casimiro has a PhD in Molecular Biology from Universidade de Lisboa, and joined Luis Costa Lab at IMM in 2007, where she is Senior Staff Scientist. Her research focus is the therapeutic targeting of RANK pathway for hard-to-treat metastatic breast cancer. She has published in 48 papers in Cell Rep Medicine, Nat Rev Urology, npg Genomic Medicine, Cancer Research, amongst others, has an [h-Index 16 and over 2,700 citations](#). She has mentored and supervised 2 PhD, 27 MSc, and 15 Graduation students. Her institutional responsibilities include IMM Biobank Scientific Committee and Review Panel of the IMM Rodent Facility Animal Welfare Committee. At the academic level, she is an [Invited Assistant Professor of Oncobiology](#) at Lisbon Medical School since 2016 (regular lecturer since 2009), and member of the Scientific Committee, Executive Coordinator and regular lecturer of the [Oncobiology Master Course](#) since 2012.
