Professor Trevor Graham is Director of the Centre for Evolution and Cancer at the Institute of Cancer Research in London, UK. He leads an interdisciplinary lab that combines mathematical modelling with molecular biology with the goal of measuring human somatic evolutionary dynamics in healthy tissue and cancer. His translational interests in cancer span early detection through to treatment of metastatic disease and he has a particular interest in colorectal carcinogenesis. Trevor was elected Fellow of the UK's Academy of Medical Sciences in 2022 for his work on cancer evolutionary genomics.
